Rather than use the time to include a peripatetic branch meeting, this year we will be using the full day as a CPD event based around recent research, current National Trust projects, and the approach to conservation at Hardwick Hall.

We will have opportunity to hear from project team members on aspects of the work including the Conservation Management Plan, building history and building archaeology, as well as an introductory reflection on the IHBC as it celebrates its 25th anniversary. Not only that, we will also have opportunity to undertake tours of the Hall to see some of the conservation issues and solutions, first hand. The day is likely to embrace all areas of competence, but the key competences will be 1 Philosophy, 2 Practice, 3 History, 4 Research, Recording and Analysis and, 8 Technology.
